The **HEAD COUNSELOR** is a part-time, seasonal position, operating Monday through Friday, 37.5 hours per week depending on enrollment. The Summer Day Camp runs from June 24th through August 9th, 2024. *This position may require additional days and hours outside of those listed above for camp planning, trainings, and events.*

Some of the responsibilities include:

- Direct, organize, and supervise assigned group of students throughout daily activities
- Implement structured, age-appropriate, engaging activities for assigned camp group
- Actively participate and engage with campers during daily activities and special events
- Encourage campers, counselors, CITs, and Jr. Staff to participate in all activities
- Guide camper behavior and seek supervisor intervention when situation escalates
- Report all accidents, incidents, and student concerns immediately to appropriate supervisor and complete necessary documentation
- Maintain and care for all program areas and supplies and ensure that campers treat all equipment and supplies responsibly
- Ensure camper to counselor ratios are maintained at all times
- Support Camp Director and Assistant Camp Director with camper drop-off and pick-up
- Be a positive role model for campers
- Maintain high standards of health, safety, and cleanliness in all activities
- Responsible for the welfare, health, safety, and whereabouts of every child in the program
- Ensure that all required standards and guidelines set forth by the Westborough Board of Health are met
- Participate in camp emergency drills and continue to revisit risk management procedures
- Attend required camp staff orientation, trainings, and daily morning meetings
- Any other relative duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years old
- At least one year experience working with school-age children, preferably in an after school or group setting
- Passion and interest in working with children in an academic and recreational setting
