The **STUDENT ASSISTANT** is a part-time, school year position, operating Monday through Friday. After school hours are 2:45pm to 5:30pm / 6:00pm, depending on the site. Additional hours are available during early release days and vacation, holiday, and professional development days.

Some of the responsibilities include:

- Assist Site Coordinator and Group Leader(s) in organizing and supervising group of students throughout daily activities
- Interact and engage with students during activities
- Arrive to site on-time, and assist in setting up / breaking down the program space
- Create a safe and welcoming environment
- Maintain high standards of health, safety, and cleanliness in all activities
- Be a positive role model for students
- Maintain positive relationships with students, families, and other school and program staff
- Communicate with Site Coordinator, including reporting all injuries, incidents, student concerns accurately and in a timely manner
- Attend staff meetings and participate in required trainings
- Participate in Early Releases and Full Day Programs
- Complies with federal, state, and district regulations and policies as outlined in the WPS Employee Handbook and the Community Ed Handbook
- Any other relative duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Must be at least 14 years of age
- Previous experience working with children ages 5-12 is required (coaching, babysitting, camp counselor, etc.)
- Passion and interest in working with children in an academic and recreational setting
