#### WAITLIST

Once a program has reached its maximum enrollment, we begin a waitlist for that specific program. If an opening becomes available, families will be contacted in the order in which they were added to the waitlist. Waitlists are monitored regularly.

#### ENRICHMENT REGISTRATION DEADLINE

The registration deadline for any Community Education enrichment program is two-weeks before the start date of the program. Registrations will not be accepted after that date. Enrichment programs will only run if we have received the requisite number of minimum registrations.

#### **ENRICHMENT CLASS LOCATION**

Details can be found in the program description. Children can attend an after school enrichment program, regardless of the school they attend. However, please note there is **NO** transportation between schools and families are responsible for getting children to other schools.

#### **PROGRAM CANCELLATIONS AND CHANGES**

All programs are offered pending sufficient enrollment and are subject to cancellation at the discretion of Westborough Community Education. We reserve the right to cancel programs that are under enrolled, and to change the times, locations, and instructors when necessary.
